

Endovascular Surgical Neuroradiology Fellowship

The Endovascular Surgical Neuroradiology Fellowship (ENS), a non-ACGME accredited program at NYUHS-Wilson Medical Center and affiliated with Upstate Medical University. It was established in 2011, and is based on the guidelines of the ACGME and has trained many talented trainees. **This is a potential J1 waiver position.** The ESN fellowship is sponsored and overseen by the Institutional Graduate Medical Education (GME) department and is located in a community based, tertiary care facility and teaching hospital. Our neurosciences academic program consists of neurosurgery, neurology and neuroradiology with close interactions with anesthesia and pulmonary critical care.

The first preparatory year is dedicated towards development of basic cognitive, clinical and radiographic skills; essentials for diagnostic interpretation and clinical decision making. In addition to the pre and intra-procedure medical management of patients with different cerebrovascular diseases requiring intervention, the first year will be dedicated to gaining clinical skills in post-operative management of patients in the critical care unit who underwent interventional procedure.

The second advanced year of training is dedicated to endovascular surgical neuroradiology interventional procedures when applied in an appropriate cerebrovascular clinical setting, using catheter-based technology. This experience includes the management of patients with neurological disease, the performance of endovascular surgical neuroradiology procedures, and the integration of endovascular surgical neuroradiology therapy into the clinical management of patients. Our endovascular surgical neuroradiology fellowship is a strong and well-balanced program which will allow our fellows the proper tools to become an excellent and competent endovascular surgical neuroradiology specialist.
