

Site Activation

Welcome to The SVIN Registry. Below you can find a description of the necessary steps for site activation. Please do not hesitate contacting us for further discussions or clarifications.

Steps for Site Activation:

1. Application at local IRB for an endovascular therapy for acute ischemic stroke Quality Assurance (QA) project.
2. REDCap Installation of SVIN Registry data dictionary.

Additional Steps for Full Site Functionality:

1. Development of a data-user agreement with the coordinating center.
2. Application at local IRB for a retrospective data analysis on endovascular therapy for acute ischemic stroke.

Quality Check:

The SVIN Registry platform utilizes REDCap, a browser-based, metadata-driven electronic-data capture software for designing and maintaining a research database.

Sites prospectively deposit locally and data is systematically exported and checked for quality, centrally, by the data coordinating center. This process occurs at 9 months for new sites and every 6 months thereafter. Random, non-scheduled quality checks to assure prospective data entry are performed. The SVIN Registry encompasses collection of mandatory and optional variables, and quality checks include the inspection for the completion rate of at least 10 mandatory variables that are randomly selected (encompassing demographics, imaging, therapeutic and outcome data; 90-modified Rankin Scale is a consistently included variable). The SVIN Registry aims to approach each institution for CPT codes to assure consecutive and comprehensive patient inclusion in the near future.

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
